Protecting Your Credit

A 2015 study of credit report accuracy by the Federal Trade Commission noted that 26% of consumers participating in the study identified an error on their credit report. About a third of these errors were loans or credit lines that did not belong to the consumer. In many instances, these misplaced or fraudulent loans/credit lines were delinquent or in collection status, severely damaging the consumer's credit score.



We highly recommend that our members keep an eye on their credit reports by using the free credit reports available from the three main credit reporting bureaus: Equifax, Experian and TransUnion. The reports are available at annualcreditreport.com. This is the official government site, and shouldn't be confused with the "free" credit report companies that advertise on TV, but require you to sign up for a costly credit monitoring service to get your free report. Each of the three bureaus is required to provide you with a free report annually, so you can spread out the requests over the year to monitor your credit every few months.

Credit Report Dispute

If you notice an error on your credit report, it is much easier to rectify the situation than it was a few years ago. All three credit reporting agencies now accept credit report disputes online. To access the online forms for each agency, click on the Free Credit Reports link under the Resources tab from the aplfcu.org home page.

Fraud Alert - ATM Skimmers

We have received reports of several ATM skimmers being found in the local area. Skimmers are small electronic devices fraudsters place over the ATM card slot to capture card information. They are often used in conjunction with a hidden camera or keypad overlay that captures your PIN when you enter it on the keypad.

If you notice any plastic pieces on the card slot or other parts of the ATM that don't look guite right, do not use that ATM. If possible, notify an employee of the business where the ATM is located, or the police if it is after hours.

Secure Communications

APL FCU's Communications Center makes it easy for members to send secure messages to the Credit Union through eBranch. To get started, log into your account and then click on the Communications Center link under the Contact Us tab.

Click on the New button to create a new mail message. You can then choose from several recipients -Address Change Services, Loan Department, Member Services, Mortgage Department, Technical Support - depending on the topic of your message. Then just type your message and hit send.

We try to respond to all Communications Center messages within 1-2 business days. Once the appropriate APL FCU staff member responds to your

message, you will see a red "You Have a New Message" button the next time you log into eBranch. Just click on it to read the response to your question.
