One of the primary ways for us to give back to our members is by maintaining the lowest fee structure in the area. 2021 was no exception, as we finished the year with the lowest fees/average assets ratio and lowest fees paid per member total of any full-service financial institution in the area*.

We also give back to members by providing some of the lowest loan rates you will find anywhere. This past year several thousand members took advantage of our 1.99% "One Rate" auto loan, our low-rate credit cards featuring 4.99% Balance Transfers for Life, and our historically low mortgage and home equity rates.

We also continued to provide COVID relief to assist members impacted by the ongoing pandemic.

In addition to the direct benefits we provide to our 27,000+ members, APL FCU's staff and Board of Directors are focused on making a difference within our community. This has taken on even greater importance with so many individuals and families affected by COVID-19.

- for from the Account History drop down box
- 4) Click the Spreadsheet link to export the data
